Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in participating in youth programming activities of the Tri-County (MD) Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated. We are planning an exciting year and are thrilled you are interested.

The Delta Academy Youth Initiative is designed for young ladies ages 11 to 14. The program focuses on self-awareness and seeks to develop young ladies with positive attitudes towards themselves and others, and who are effective and optimistic problem solvers that are confident about their future.

The Delta G.E.M.S. Youth Initiative is designed for young women ages 14 to 18 who are in the 9th through 12th grades. G.E.M.S. is an acronym for Growing & Empowering Myself Successfully. The curriculum focuses on programs and activities that sharpen as well as enhance leadership skills by promoting high levels of academic success and emphasizing decision-making and planning for college.

The EMBODI Youth Initiative is designed for young men ages 11 to 18. EMBODI is an acronym for Empowering Males to Building Opportunities for Developing Independence. The program addresses issues related to STEM education, culture, leadership, character, ethics, college readiness, civic engagement, and service learning.

Delta's youth programming activities are an 8-month commitment. These sessions will be comprised of fun, interactive, educational and community service activities. Although we recognize that participants may be involved in numerous other academic, athletic and/or extracurricular school activities, it is expected that young females and males attend each session. Our sessions are usually held on the **3rd or 4th (EMBODI) Saturday** of each month, from approximately **10 a.m. to 1 p.m.**, beginning in **October 2021** and ending in **May 2022**. There may be instances when dates and times change, and/or additional activities are scheduled for public service projects and/or field trips.

Each session is designed for and centered on the participants. To fully benefit from our program, participants need to attend each scheduled session (with no more than 2 absences). We do reserve the right to remove participants from the program who do not follow our attendance policy. Participants must attend at least 75% of the sessions.

Interested participants:

- Have potential, but need guidance, support, and skills to achieve success
- Are interested in developing leadership skills
- Are actively pursuing college after high school or other career options and need encouragement and support in pursuit of higher learning
- Demonstrate risk in at least one area of the following: socio-economic status, single parent home, learning disability, teenage mother, attending low performing school, court involved youth and/or offspring of those incarcerated
- Can consistently attend most meetings, programs and scheduled service projects planned predominately for the 3rd or 4th (EMBODI) Saturday of each month (75% attendance rate)

Please be sure to complete the attached application in its entirety and submit the application (postmarked or emailed) by **September 24, 2021**. (Parent/applicant signature is required where specified). Electronic signature is acceptable.

Applications not filled out completely and/or not submitted by the postmarked date specified will be in jeopardy for non-acceptance into the youth programming activities for the 2021-2022 year. Notification of acceptance will be sent to parents and a calendar of the program activities will be provided to all young ladies and men who are accepted into the programs during the program kickoff and parent orientation event scheduled for mid-October.
