Soror Pamela E. Smith is a nationally-recognized educator who has been on the forefront of school innovations throughout her career. Currently, Soror Smith is a part-time professor at Cleveland State University. Formerly, she was CEO of Smart Pedagogic Solutions, LLC, an education consulting company.

She retired in August 2010 as the Chief of Staff of the Cleveland Metropolitan School District. Prior to that Soror Smith was an assistant superintendent in the Cleveland Heights-University Heights School District. Soror Smith attended Harvard University for special training in the Executive Leadership for Educators and the Leadership and New Technologies Programs. She is a Board Member of the MetroHealth Foundation, 2013-Present and Recipient of Cleveland State University Outstanding Instructor Award, 2018. She earned her Bachelor of Science at The Ohio State University and her Master of Arts at Cleveland State University.

Soror Smith is a 50+year Golden Life Member. She was inducted at The Ohio State University and was a charter member of the Glen Ellyn Area Alumnae Chapter. A former president of Greater Cleveland Alumnae Chapter, she is currently its advisor. She was Ohio Soror of the Year in 2018 and Midwest Region Soror of the Year in 2005.

Soror Smith chaired the Educational Development Sub-Committee of the National Program Planning and Development Committee, 2017-2021 and co-chaired the Grow with Google national initiative. She served as a member of the National Honorary Members Task Force and chair of the Honorary Members Selection Sub-Committee, 2013-2017. Soror Smith served 17 consecutive years on the National Board of Directors as co-chair Leadership Academy, 2008-2013; National Secretary, 2006-2008; and chair Program Planning and Development; 1996-2006.
